Alabama-Coushatta

Indian Tribal Council Employment & Training Program



Alabama-Coushatta provides educational and employment opportunities to eligible Native Americans/American Indians. Eligibility for Alabama-Coushatta services includes:

- Must belong to a federally recognized tribe
- Must have CDIB (Certificate Degree of Indian Blood)
- Approval must be made through Alabama Coushatta's main office.

Please be aware that Alabama Coushatta will only pay for Certificate programs.

Motivation Education & Training (MET)

The Motivation Education & Training (MET) program provides community service and subsidized work-based job training for seniors through Senior Community Service Employment Program (SCSEP) funding. To qualify, individuals must be:

- Must be 55 or older
- Must be unemployed
- Must meet low-income requirements

Participants are paid to work approximately 20 hours a week for nonprofit organizations, school districts or government offices to receive work-based training.

Texas Veterans Commission

In partnership with the Texas Veterans Commission, **Veteran staff located in our Workforce Centers** provide a full range of **employment services** to veterans such as:

- Information on Veterans Benefits and Training Opportunities

Vocational Rehabilitation Services

The Texas Workforce Commission's **Vocational Rehabilitation Services** program provides individuals with disabilities assistance in obtaining, retaining, or advancing in employment, including training opportunities. Program eligibility includes:

- Must have a severe physical and/or mental disability
- The disability affects your ability to work
- Vocational Rehabilitation services are needed in order to obtain, retain, or maintain employment
- Individual is able to obtain and maintain a job after receiving services
