Myth: In order to receive assistance from Child Care Services, I must apply for child support.

Fact: Child Care Services DOES NOT require you to apply for child support to receive services. Additionally, we DO NOT count any income you receive from child support.



Myth: In order to receive Child Care Services, the parent(s) must be a U.S. citizen.

Fact: Parent(s) are not required to be citizens of the United States. Only the children must be U.S. citizens.



Myth: I make too much money to qualify for Child Care Services assistance.

Fact: The Child Care Services income limits are much higher than other social services programs. See our website for more details.



Myth: In order to receive assistance from Child Care Services, I must work a full-time job.

Fact: Child Care Services provides assistance to part-time employees, teen parents, active deployed military, and college students.



Myth: In order to receive assistance from Child Care Services, I have to be a single parent.

Fact: Child Care Services provides assistance to single parents, two-parent families, grandparents, and legal guardians.
